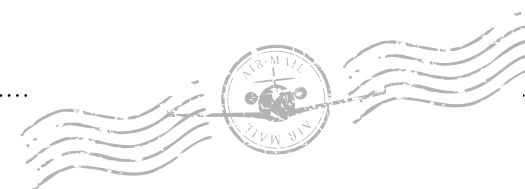
8. **Pieno Sud Bianco** SICILIA, ITALY **£7.50 £16.00 £26.50**
This delicately perfumed blend of native Sicilian grape varieties offers ripe pear and red apple fruit, a hint of spice and lemony crispness on the finish.
9. **Grillo Feudo Arancio** SICILIA, ITALY **£29.50**
Tropical notes of mango and papaya combine beautifully with hints of jasmine and acacia flowers.
10. **Orvieto Classico Secco Campogrande Marchesi Antinori** **£34.00**
UMBRIA, ITALY
Refined, elegant Orvieto showing typical floral aromas. The palate is fruity and well balanced.
11. **Pinot Grigio Riserva, Mezzacorona** **£8.75 £18.50 £35.00**
TRENTINO, ITALY
Very clean, nicely balanced Pinot Grigio, with a gentle floral aroma, good medium weight in the mouth, and a refreshing finish.
12. **Sauvignon Blanc Castel Firmian, Mezzacorona** **£9.00 £19.50 £36.00**
TRENTINO, ITALY
A fresh, invigorating nose of cut grass, elderflower and currant leaf leads to a dry, citrusy, but still quite rounded palate. This roundness alongside a delicately mineral finish is typical Trentino - this is an excellent marriage of grape variety and location.
13. **Chardonnay Tormaresca** PUGLIA, ITALY **£10.50 £22.25 £39.50**
Bright, fruity, medium-bodied Chardonnay showing the purity and richness of Puglian fruit.
14. **Vernaccia di San Gimignano Teruzzi & Puthod** **£40.00**
TOSCANA, ITALY
Elegant nose of apple and mineral, followed by an engagingly intense palate, full of green apple and almond, leading to an appetizing Chablis-like finish.
15. **Gavi di Gavi La Meirana, Bruno Broglia** **£12.00 £26.00 £45.50**
PIEMONTE, ITALY
Great texture and precision, with distinctive greengage and almond notes on the palate. Fresh and dry, this is a characterful Gavi.

16. **Greco di Tufo, Tenute Altavilla, Villa Matilde** CAMPANIA, ITALY **£46.00**
Bold flavours of white peach and apricot give way to notes of citrus and an appealing mineral streak. The palate is rich and well-structured and the finish leaves a subtle yet lingering flavour of sweet almonds.
17. **Nozze d'Oro, Tasca** SICILY, ITALY **£70.00**
Fresh, young and surprisingly prone to longevity, balances the tertiary aromas with the intensity of the fruit.
18. **Cervaro della Sala, Antinori** UMBRIA, ITALY **£125.00**
Intense, complex aroma with notes of white flowers and flint balanced by a hint of vanilla. Full-bodied and well-structured palate with notes of toast, citrus and mineral. Elegant and persistent in the mouth, this is a wine with a long life ahead of it.

19. **Picpoul de Pinet St Clair, Luvignac** LANGUEDOC FRANCE **£34.00**
Elegant aromas of citrus, pear and white flowers and a crisp, mineral palate ideally suited to seafood.
20. **Malagouzia/Assyrtiko, Thymiopoulos** MACEDONIA, GREECE **£45.00**
The perfect marriage of the rich stone fruit and floral flavours of Malagouzia with the acidity and minerality of Assyrtiko, which adds freshness and complexity to the finish.
21. **Dog Point Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough (Organic)** **£50.00**
MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND
Crammed full of mouth-watering acidity with ripe tropical fruits, enticing aromas of melon and lemongrass, complimented by a citrus backbone with underlying flint and minerality.

27.	Montepulciano d'Abruzzo Tre Saggi, Talamonti ABRUZZO, ITALY The Abruzzo region on Italy's Adriatic coast has with its Montepulciano grape variety the potential for one of Italy's great wines. 32.	Amarone della Valpolicella Classico Brigaldara VENETO, ITALY Made from dried grapes in the Valpolicella's Classico and best region and with a full, dry flavour. An enormous, muscular wine with tones of damsons and herbs.	£85.00
33.	Barolo Alfredo Prunotto PIEMONTE, ITALY Complex nose with notes of rose, strawberry and forest fruits. Delicately floral, perfumed yet persistent on the palate, this is Barolo at its best.	£95.00
34.	Brunello di Montalcino, Pian delle Vigne, Antinori TUSCANY, ITALY Complex, generous nose with ripe aromas of cherries and raspberries, light tobacco notes and hints of coffee and cocoa powder. Malbec & Corvina Organic Passo Doble Tierra Soleada, Masi Tupungato MENDOZA, ARGENTINA Fragrant and complex on the nose with ripe fruits-of-the-forest aromas enhanced by notes of cinnamon and vanilla. Up-front and powerful on the palate with hints of spice and cooked cherries followed by a long appetising finish.	£37.50
36.	Finca Valpiedra Rioja Reserva RIOJA, SPAIN That rare thing: a single-vineyard Rioja, offering a powerful expression of black fruit, white chocolate, plums and spices. These aromas are perfectly combined with the smokiness provided by French oak barrels. Round and full-bodied with an elegant, ripe structure and a long, silky, persistent finish.	£62.00
37.	Bourgogne Pinot Noir, Michelot BURGUNDY, FRANCE A Bourgogne Rouge of unusual depth and intensity, with perfumed blackberry/black cherry fruit, medium full body, and a long floral finish.	£80.00
38.	Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Domaine de Beurenard (Organic) RHÔNE VALLEY, FRANCE An immensely fruity nose, with spicy and balsamic notes. Great complexity on the palate: power, finesse, and an incredibly long, mineral fresh finish.	£95.00

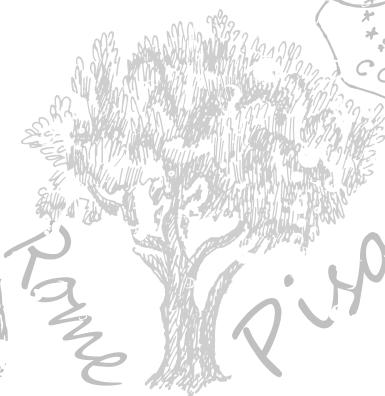
